- _____ Record of receipt of the MCCS Giving Servant Award (MCCS will confirm)
- _____ Letter of recommendation from an unrelated scouting leader
- _____ Letter of recommendation from an unrelated church leader (elder, deacon, minister or teacher)
- _____ Letter of recommendation from an unrelated teacher, counselor or school administrator
- _____ 2 page essay "What Having the Heart of a Servant Means to Me"
- _____ Resume of your accomplishments
